

## Getting the Words Right

The movement of people from one area or country to another in search of work or a different lifestyle.

A special legal immigration status (a special protection by a country) given to people who are recognised as refugees.

People who make an application for asylum (refuge) in a country other than their own

The process of people arriving at and passing through the control at a border with another country

Belonging to a country in which a person is born and in which that person has legal rights and responsibilities (or is given the same rights as someone born in the same country).

**Asylum Seeker**

A person who enters a different country from their own in order to settle and make a life there.

Traffickers are people who take migrants within or across borders illegally and charge money for it.

Any person who, owing to a well-founded fear of being persecuted (badly treated) for reasons of race, religion, nationality, membership of a particular social group or political opinion, is outside the country of his nationality and is unable or unwilling to return to it.

People who do not live in a country who go there for short stays and for holidays. They may need visas (a special passport stamp) and cannot stay longer than a year
